The Abrahamic Forum's Achievements in Tunisia

In partnership with the University of Zaytuna, the Institute for Theological Studies, the PhD Program and the Anda-Arab World, the Abrahamic Forum carried out an international conference on Interfaith Dialogue and Pluralism between Abrahamic Faiths in Hammamet on Thursday **20 June 2019**.

Achievements:

- ❑ implementation of field-work projects targeting young people affiliated with the three Abrahamic religions
- ❑ including a visit of the holy place of Jewish pilgrims in Djerba and a field trip to a church and a synagogue in Tunisia
- ❑ we planned to carry out an environmental activity for a group of young people (e. g. cleaning beaches, mosques and neighborhoods)

Due to the COVID 19 lockdown these projects had to be postponed

Suggestions for future activities

- carry out our forth-coming activities through civic associations especially with respect to the relationship between Jewish and Muslim communities in Tunisia
- city of Djerba as a central carrefour of interfaith and pluralism
- conference in May 2021 between Muslims and Jews
- environmental activities beaches, mosques, churches and synagogues of youngsters from Christian, Jewish and Islamic faiths to carry out an environmental activity together in in 2020-2021
- Organize an interfaith dialogue between Abrahamic faiths to clarify their positions with regard to terrorism
- Publish and translate (into German) the works of the previous conference on "Interfaith Dialogue and Pluralism between Abrahamic Faiths"
